1865 BOWMANVILLE, 18th May - \$295 promissory note.

Payment details are noted on the back as is typical for these notes and is slightly noticeable from the front.

This 159 years old note is written on a nice quality laid paper - it is in amazing condition considering its age. If my memory serves me correctly, this is the only document I have even seen from Bowmanville, Ontario.

The 9c 1st bill issue pays the required 9c rate (3c per \$100)

BCD2b* - 1947 Duck stamp complete booklet with 10 complete booklet panes of 4.

When I first started out in the business in early 1970 I was told by a Vancouver, British Columbia old-time stamp dealer that apparently most if not all of these booklets were affected by humidity right after they were printed, with the result that most of the mint booklet panes have slight gum adhesion from the next pane they were up against. This mostly affected the bottom 2 stamps. **The 10th pane is completely mint never hinged.** Many of the BCD2 stamps and panes in collector's hands are without gum and apparently most of these had the gum soaked off right after these stamps were issued. If you take a look at any of the surviving *NH panes you will most likely see some kind of adhesion. This booklet is no different.

This might well be one of the last surviving complete booklets. Catalogue value is \$1900

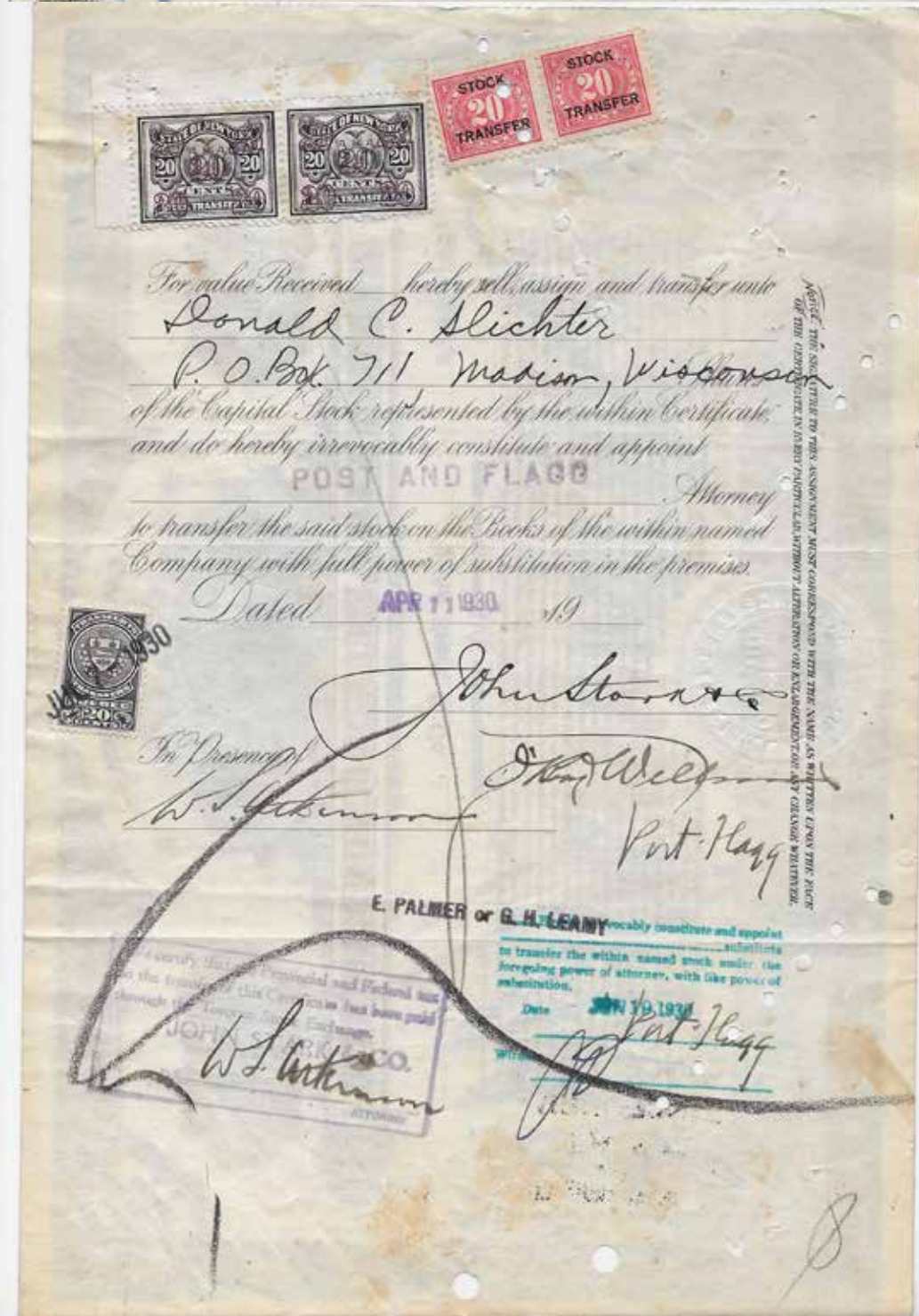

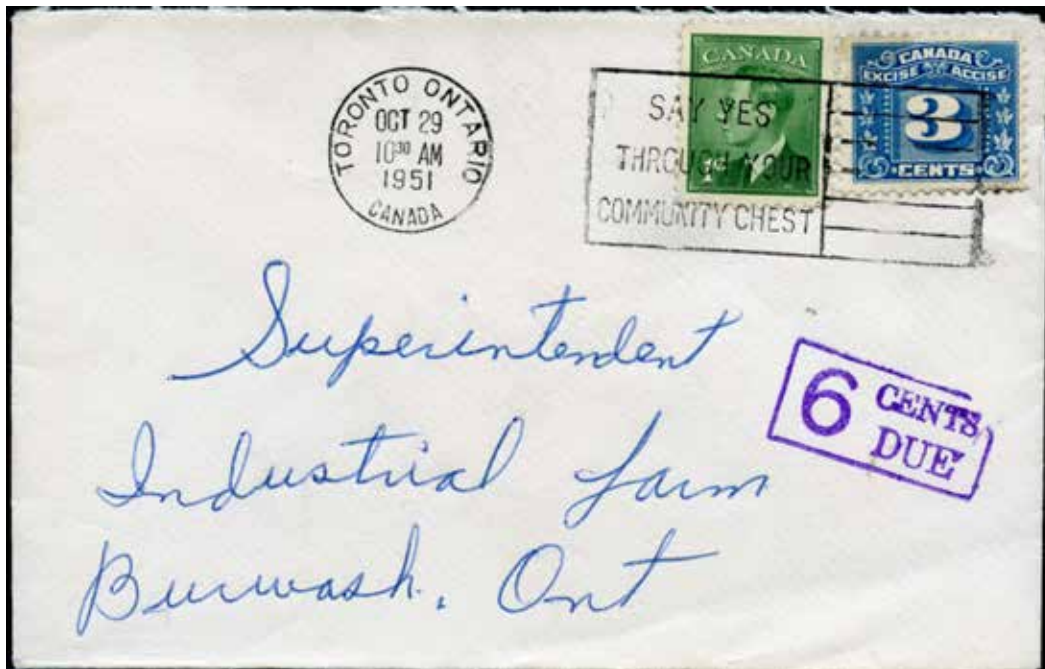

Queen Victoria

In April 1865, the American Bank Note Company replaced its first issue with one of much higher quality, an issue which was intaglio printed from line-engraved plates in sheets of 100 stamps (10 x 10 format). All were perforated 12 except the blue cents values, which were perforated 13.5.

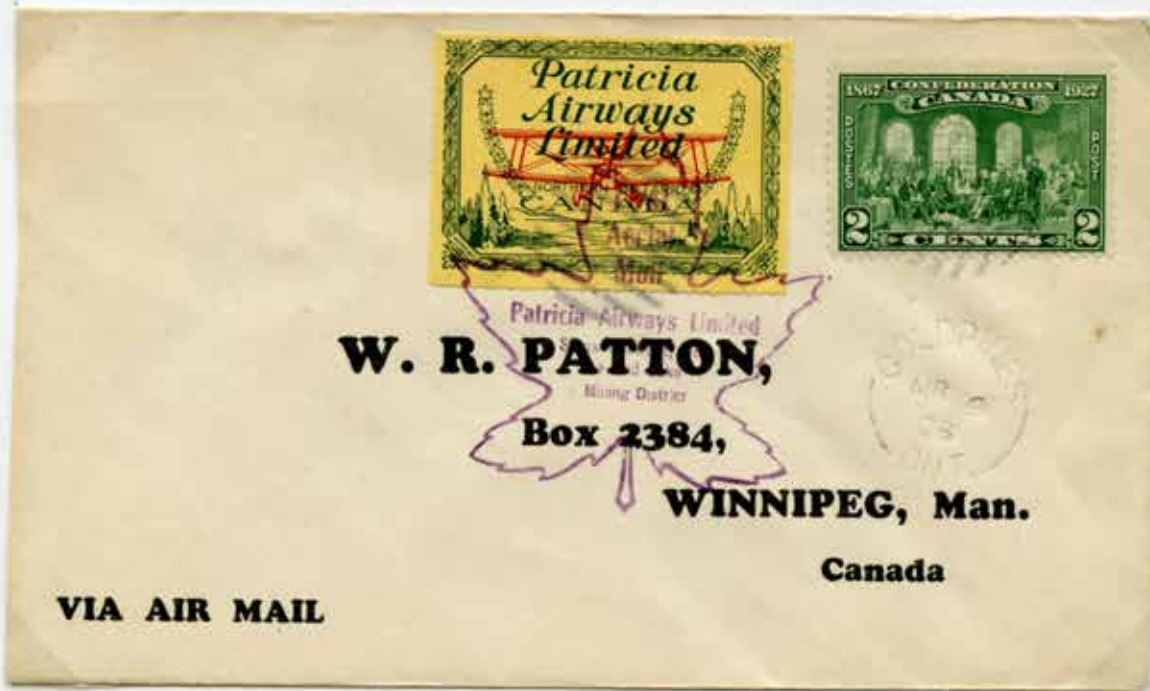
