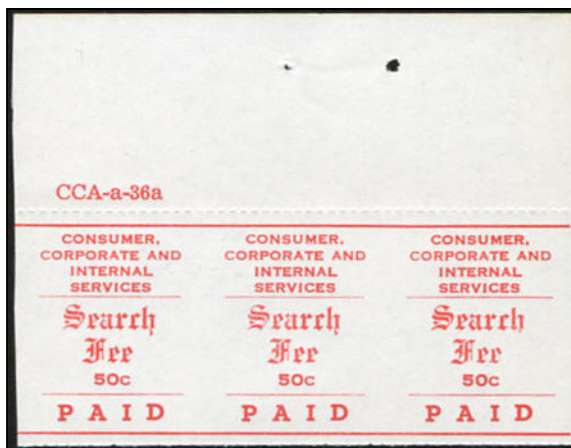

Alberta AP1a - 1936 Prosperity Certificate + strip of 3 mint never hinged AP1.

This is the actual certificate to which the stamps were to be affixed.

The act was declared illegal very early on and the stamps and certificates could be returned to the Alberta government for a refund.

This is one of the nicest certificates I have seen. Without the usual folds, creases and signs of wear.

There are a couple of small hinge remnants on the back as can be seen on the scan.

QL33 - 20c gray violet + QL43 - \$1 green.

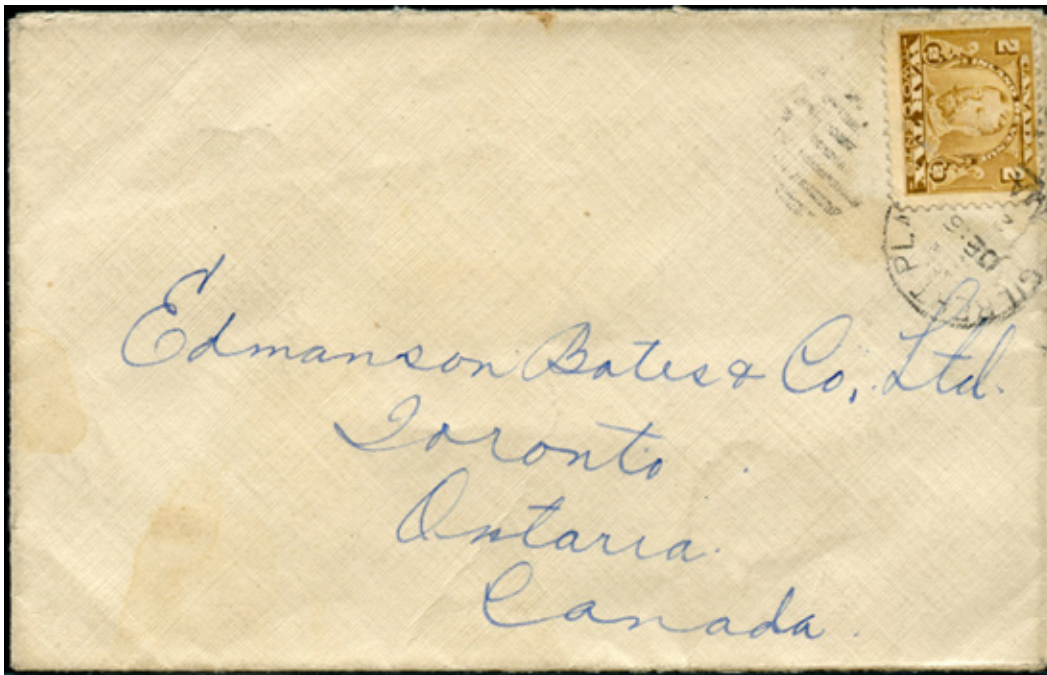

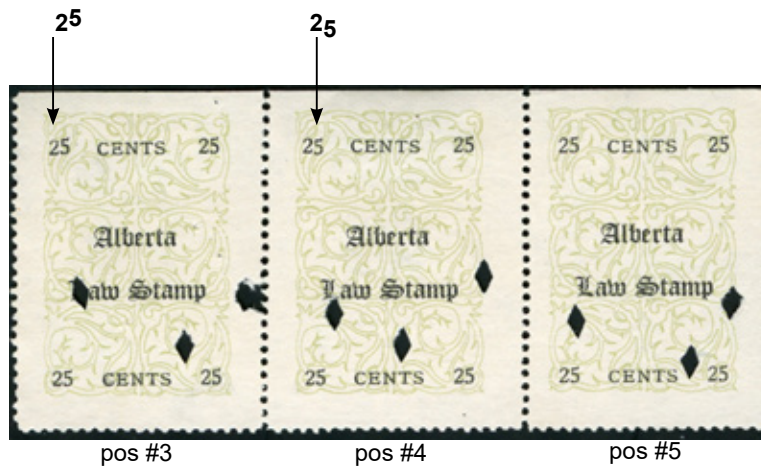

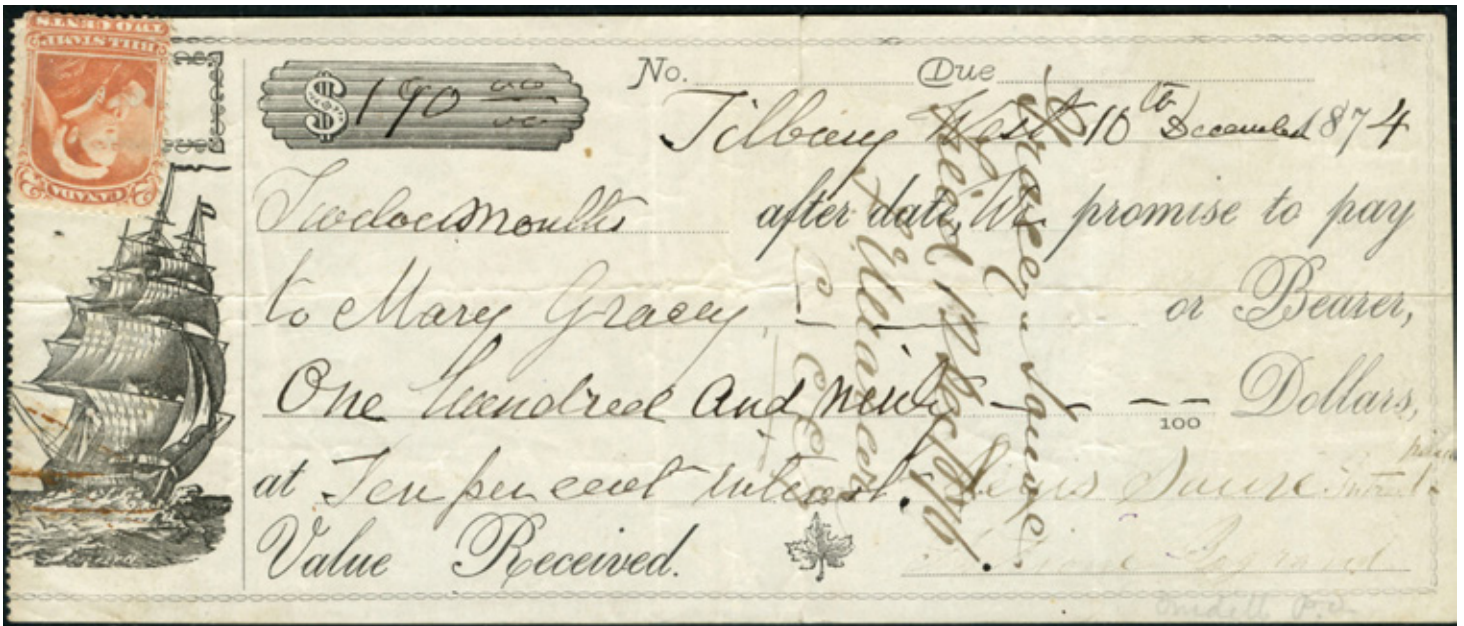
